More than a decade after the formulation of fundamental theses on value-based competition (Porter/Teisberg, 2006) and their adaptation for the Swiss healthcare system (Teisberg, 2008), approaches to value-based healthcare are still in their infancy. Our aim is to pave the way for value-based medicine and healthcare (VBHC) in order to enable continuous further development and value-oriented optimisation of the Swiss healthcare system. The VBHCSUISSE association aims to promote initiatives, instruments, and measures to improve the quality of treatment. Particular importance is attached to the systematic and standardised measurement of results at individual patient level using Patient Reported Outcome Measures (PROMs) and the optimised use of available resources for sustainable patient centricity.
